**1**  **BUILD YOUR TEAM**

**4**  **GET RACE FIT**

**5**  **KEEP RAISING MONEY**

With a few weeks to go, there's plenty of time to get the team together and share some fundraising ideas. You can organise games on the day, hold a raffle or set up a stall selling healthy snacks, it all helps.

**6**  **SPREAD THE WORD**

With the excitement building, why not lead a special assembly to tell your fellow pupils what it's all about? This is the moment to inspire your classmates and explain how the money you raise together for Cancer Research UK will help beat cancer sooner.

**7**  **ON THE DAY**
